

2024 Florida State Series

1. USA BMX State Team competition consists of two classifications:
 - Trophy Team - competes for trophies
 - Money Team - competes for cash awards
2. Teams must submit and maintain a roster of team members each season, in writing, with the State Coordinator.
3. These rosters shall be posted on the official State Facebook page.
4. The State Team Coordinator reserves the right to determine which category a team is considered competing in; Money or Trophy.
5. **Teams adding riders to their roster must do so prior to close of registration for that day's race.**
This must be submitted with the team roster form, which will be available at registration or on-line. The rider/parent (if a minor) must sign the forms in order to be eligible for team competition.
6. Maximum numbers of riders on a team roster is **limited to 20 riders**.
7. Any rider dropped or removing themselves from a team, the following criteria apply:
 - **Riders dropped from a team shall be ineligible for team competition for a period of 30 calendar days.**
 - If a team dissolves during a season, a rider has to wait the 30 days before being rostered to another team.
8. The above period commencing on the date that the State Team Coordinator receives notification by either the rider and/or the parent (if a minor). Notification must be in writing submitted in person at registration or via email to the attention of the State Coordinator. (Rider & parents: if you are released from a team, notify the State Team Coordinator immediately to ensure that the rider is correctly removed from a team roster.)
9. Money team rostered riders will not be NOT eligible for Trophy team competition for the remainder of the current state racing season.
10. Novice riders cannot be rostered on a money team
11. Any Pro rider re-classed to amateur by USA BMX shall be ineligible for team competition for a period of 90 days from the date of reclassification approval.
12. **All team rosters shall be final after February 1, 2024, teams may not make any changes to their rosters.**
13. All team riders must wear their team jersey during competition.
14. A team may enter up to two team sheets per race. Only the best of the two scores will be counted towards that days results but both sheets can count towards the season overall. (In case of miscalculation it is recommended to turn in both team sheets from that race day.)
15. Team entry fees (limit of two (2) per day) consist of the following:
 - \$10.00 per Trophy Team Sheet - limit 2 per day
 - \$30.00 per Money Team Sheet - limit 2 per day
16. A State Trophy team sheet may enter up six riders which can be any combination of Novice, Inter, Expert, Girl, Cruiser/Girl Cruiser or Open.
17. A State Money team sheet may enter up six riders which can be any combination of **Inter, Expert, Expert Girl, or Cruiser/Girl Cruiser or Open.**
18. A rider can only used once on a team sheet.
19. Teams may use a rider on two team sheets on a given day but said rider must be entered in different classes (ie..class on one sheet and cruiser or open on the other sheet).
20. **Team sheets must be turned in before close of registration for that day's race.**
21. A rider not qualifying for the main (DNQ) will received zero (0) points.
22. Series overall team standings will be determined from the best seven (7) State Race (SCR) scores plus the State Final (SCF) which will count as DOUBLE team points. To be eligible for year end team awards a team must participate in at least 50% of the SCR races and the SCF.
23. Unofficial results will be announced at the conclusion of each event. Official results will be determined after validating each team sheet's rider eligibility, finishes and point total with the State Team Coordinator.
24. Team sheet ties will broken with a count of the number of 1sts, 2nds, 3rds, etc. from the tied sheets.
25. The SCF will be the first overall series tie-breaker
26. **Results will be published under team results on www.sunshinesatebm.com.**
27. Trophy Team awards at each SCR/SCF:
 - Distribution:
 - 1st thru 4th place = Trophy
 - 1st place team can participate in parade lap the next race day
28. Money team purse at each SCR/SCF will be as follows
 - \$200 per plus 100% payback to top four teams per day.
 - Breakout will be 50% - 25% - 15% - 10%
 - Prize money will distributed by check via the USABMX Office after validating each team sheet's rider eligibility, finishes and point total with the State Team Coordinator.
29. All Teams/Riders will use the below points table for both Trophy and Money team sheets
30. **A rider must meet all of the Florida State race requirements to be used on a team sheet at the final.**

State Team Sheet

1. USA BMX State Team competition consists of two categories:
 - Money Team
 - Trophy Team
2. Teams may enter up to two (2) team sheets per day.
3. Novice riders cannot be used on a Money team sheet.
4. A team may enter up to six riders on a team sheet.
5. Teams may use a rider on two team sheets on a given day but said rider must be entered in different classes (ie..class on one sheet and cruiser or open on the other sheet).
6. A rider not qualifying for the main (DNQ) will received zero (0) points.
7. A teams best four scores will be counted on an individual team sheet.
8. The team sheet with the highest score wins their respective category.
9. In the case of a tie, tie-breakers will be determined by a count of the number of 1sts, 2nds, 3rds, etc. from the tied sheets.
10. If a tie still exists, both teams will be credited with the same finish.
11. All Series overall team scores will be counted as follows:
 - Standings will count the best seven (7) SCR races plus the SCF for year-end overall.
 - The SCF will count as double team points.
 - In case of a tie, the SCF will be first the tie breaker.
12. The State Team Coordinator reserves the right to determine which category a team is considered competing in; Money or Trophy.
13. **Team sheets must be turned in before close of registration for that day's race.**
